

RP3 Results & Pre-Examination Update

Dear Parent / Carer

Following the year 13 PPE assessment week (w/c 15.04.24) you will shortly receive your child's RP3 data.

The data sheet includes:

- MEG (Minimum Expected Grade)
- Final A level predicted grade *
- Revision score
- Assessment grade
- PLC (Personal Learning Checklist) targets

*(*The final A level predicted grade is a professional prediction of what we believe the student is capable of achieving based on their performance throughout their A level studies. Students have been advised to use this information when confirming their first choice and insurance choice universities. Our advice is for students to be aspirational when confirming their first-choice university and ensure their insurance choice has lower entry requirements).*

It is important students use this information, in addition to the subject specific feedback from their assessment papers, to identify gaps in knowledge and inform their ongoing revision.

With the A level examinations due to commence on Tuesday 14th May, I would also like to take this opportunity to share with you the package of support on offer throughout the examinations to ensure your child achieves their potential.

From Monday 20th May onwards, all year 13 students will be on study leave. During this time sixth form staff will be on hand, as per their normal teaching timetable, to provide drop-in clinics to support students right up to their final examinations. Each department has created a timetable highlighting what content will be delivered in each drop-in clinic to help students best plan their revision. All timetables can be located [here](#).

We have also put in place a series of revision sessions (timetable attached) offering support and guidance relevant to specific A level examination papers prior to the final examinations. These revision sessions are compulsory and we would appreciate your support in ensuring your child attends.
