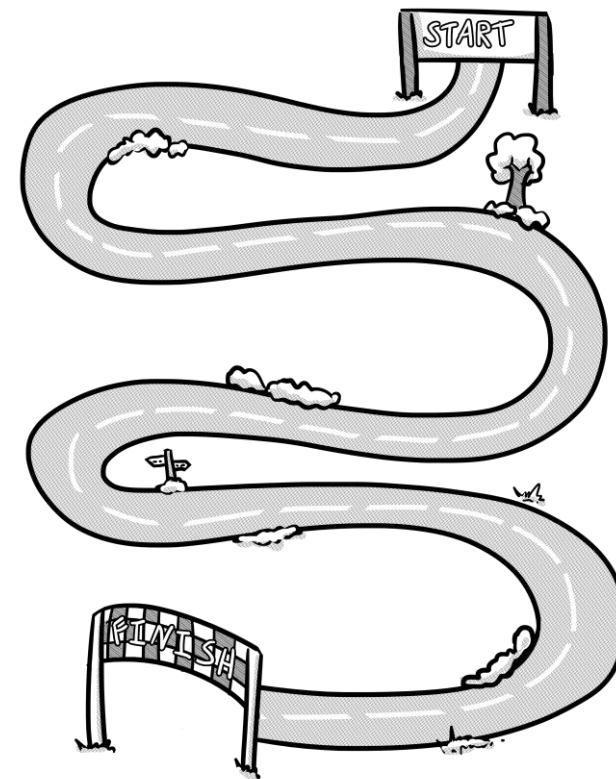


Lesson 8

How can you improve further in Y12?

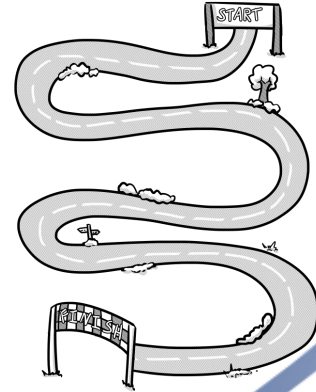
Staying in your groups:

- What three things do you think you could have done better? E.g. getting work in on time, doing more effective notes in class, participating more in group work. Rank your responses from the one that will have the biggest impact to the least.
- Make these the three things that you want to improve upon over the next half term; as a group, come up with strategies that might help. E.g. if you're not getting your work done on time, write two dates in your calendar: the deadline AND when you need to START the work so you meet the deadline.
- If you have had a tutor review, consider the actions that arose from this meeting as well.

Look at the Roadmap you created

Well, how have you done? Compare your Roadmap with your list and with what you have recorded in your log book.

- There may be things that you haven't achieved – YET! Move these into Y12.
- Add any extras that you've done that you hadn't planned for.
- Do you want to change any of your targets for Y12?
